Gee holds that you cannot engage in a Discourse in a less than fully fluent manner: you are either in or you are not.

We take discourse or discourses to refer to systems of meaningful practices that form the identities of subjects and objects.¹² At this lower level of abstraction, discourses are concrete systems of social relations and practices that are intrinsically political, as their
